Assembling *Table Tent Cards*

1. From 1 - 4, fold along the lines.
2. Keep Kai on the outside of the folds.
3. Overlap and tape the bottom folds to keep the *Table Tent Card* sturdy.
4. After class, collect the *Table Tent Cards* to use next week.

Kids play with the *Story Cards* to re-create and explore the Bible story.



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
